We have a new e-bike policy. If you have an e-bike please read the policy that was put in your cubby. Thank you.



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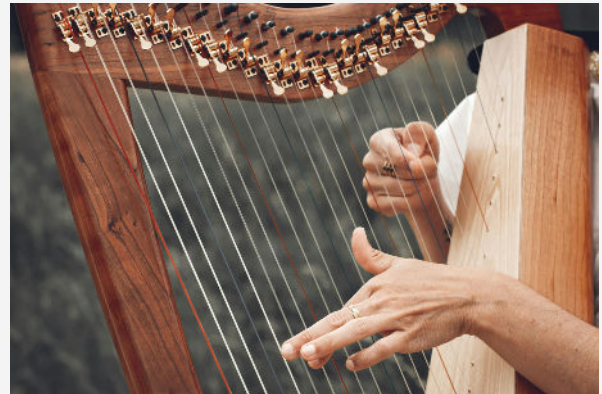
Upcoming Events
